Finals will be disputed by maximum 24 athletes.</p>
Competition Forms	<p>Individuals: Gold – Silver and Bronze medals will be given in each individual category and gender. The fastest time will be declared the winner.</p> <p>Team events: Biathle and Triathle Mixed Relay means 2 athletes (1 woman + 1 man) from the same Nation in each category. If there are different categories in one team, the race marshals will decide which category the team will be ranked. Biathle Teams of 3 are formed by comprising the highest individual placed 3 biathletes from the same nation in each category and will have their times added together. The fastest time will be declared the winner. The same with Triathle Teams.</p>



	<p>For the classification of European Championships, only athletes of an official ECMP Federation will get ranked.</p> <p>All other athletes will get ranked in the Open Championships classification. No Team event will be carried out with less than 3 teams.</p>
