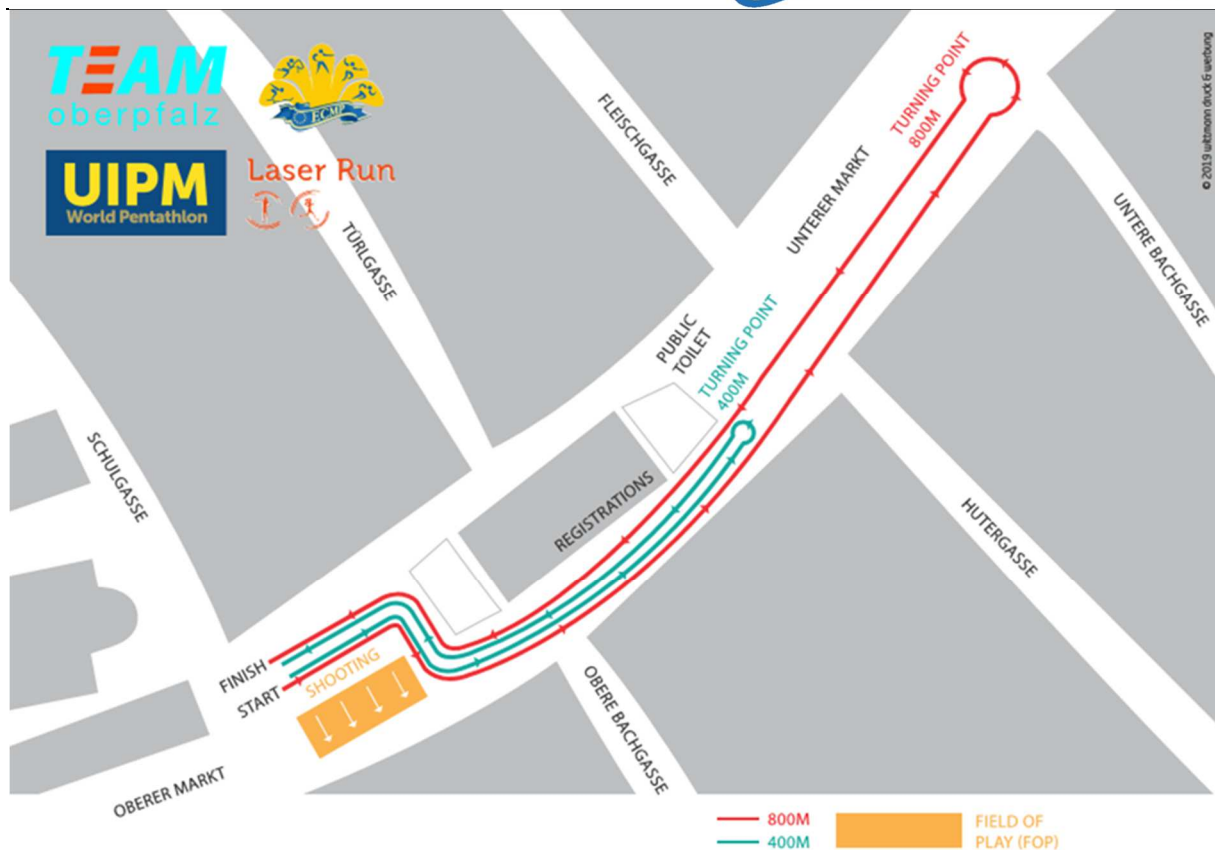

Competition Forms	<p>Individuals: Gold – Silver and Bronze medals will be given in each individual category and gender. The fastest time will be declared the winner.</p> <p>Team events: Mixed Relay means 2 athletes (1 woman + 1 man) from the same Nation in each category. If there are different categories in one team, the race marshals will decide which category the team will be ranked (we will allow most combinations). Teams of 3 are formed by comprising the highest individual placed 3 athletes from the same nation in each category and will have their times added together. The fastest time will be declared the winner.</p> <p>For the Elite classification of European Championships, only athletes with a license of an official ECMP Federation will get ranked. All other athletes will get ranked in the Open Division.</p>
